

# Reactivate an expired LMACS account



After a period of inactivity (typically 1 year) your LMACS account will become inactive. Re-activating your account is relatively simple - the steps are outlined here.

## Step-by-step guide

1. Point your browser to the [LMACS](http://admin.nanofab.ualberta.ca) site - [admin.nanofab.ualberta.ca](http://admin.nanofab.ualberta.ca)
2. Click **Reactivate**
3. Enter your email address - Click **Re-Activate**
4. You will receive an email with instructions to complete the re-activation process. You can use your existing password. If you've forgotten this - you can [reset your password](#).
5. You will be taken to the **Account Configuration** step of the registration process. For details on how to proceed - visit the [Create an LMACS account](#) how-to.
